

Summer Travel B - 2024 Rules

1. General

- a. Blue Book rules - Regular Season
- b. Continuous Batting Order for all games
- c. Courtesy Runner permitted as this is an allowed Regular Season Option
- d. Everyone plays two innings in the field minimum
- e. Fifteen, Ten, and Eight run rules are in effect
- f. No Butcher Boy (Fake bunt / swing away) - will result in dead ball, batter is out, and no advancement
- g. 12U - Intermediate rules - 7 innings, etc.
- h. 10U, 11U - majors rules w/ dropped 3rd strike
- i. 9U - majors rules, no drop 3rd strike

2. Schedules

- a. Home vs. Away - Regular Season
 - i. Home team procures umpire(s) and occupies first base dugout
 - ii. Away team supplies baseballs (RS baseballs are ok!) and occupies third base dugout
- b. Must play at least 6 games against teams in the program to qualify for the Tournament. For teams playing less than 8 games, each game under 8 played will be considered a loss.
- c. Can play eliminated Tournament teams or Friendship teams, but those games will not count towards seeding or minimum number of games required to play.
- d. Games played in other Tournaments against other teams playing Travel B can be counted towards the minimum number of games required.

3. Website

- a. Put in your schedule
- b. Email District1Summer@gmail.com your roster - spreadsheet with number, first name, last name - failure to do so will be grounds for removal from the program and/or exclusion from playoffs
- c. Winning team responsible for entering score within 48 hours - failure to do so will be grounds for removal from the program and/or exclusion from playoffs
- d. Both teams must put in pitch counts on the website - failure to do so will be grounds for removal from the program and/or exclusion from playoffs
- e. We will send out the instructions on how to do schedules, scores, and pitch counts

4. Roster Changes - Email changes to District1Summer@gmail.com

- a. Non-District Tournament Players
 - i. No restrictions
- b. Addition of Players from eliminated District Tournament teams
 - i. Only two max can be added **and to only get you to ten players**
 - ii. MUST be at end of your running batting order
 - iii. Cannot pitch

5. Playoffs

- a. Seeding at discretion of District staff (generally winning pct, head-to-head)
- b. Higher seed is "HOME" and will occupy the first base dugout
- c. Home site supplies umpires until Semifinals - then District will assign umpires
- d. Both teams bring 2-3 baseballs for each game
- e. Trophies for 1st and 2nd place teams
- f. Single elimination starting around Sunday July 21, exact dates to be finalized by July 15
- g. Finals are expected to be Saturday, July 27 with a rain date of Sunday, July 28, but may be pulled in depending on the number of teams playing.
